



## ELIGIBILITY

Open to amateur golfers who live or are employed within Shawnee County. Note exception for City Stroke Play and City Senior Stroke Play. **Each player must be a member of the Topeka Golf Association (TGA) by paying an annual fee of \$5.00.**

## DRESS

Players must be properly attired at all times both on the golf course and in public rooms of hosting course. Blue jeans, tee shirts and tank tops are prohibited; shorts must be at least mid-thigh. This dress code will be used at all TGA tournaments and qualifying rounds. **All players will also adhere to any stricter dress codes of the hosting course.** Contestants will comply with the golf spike policy in effect at the host course.

## CITY 3-PERSON SCRAMBLE

Tee times for this tournament will not be listed in the newspaper. Tee times can be obtained by calling Cypress Ridge GC at 291-2670 or checking [www.topekagolf.org](http://www.topekagolf.org) four days prior to the event. We anticipate the tournament will start at 9:30. Lunch is included.

## CITY STROKE PLAY

For this tournament the entry field will be open to Jackson County residents as well. All players entered will play four rounds. The low 40 and ties will play Firekeeper GC in rounds 3 and Topeka CC in round 4. The remaining field will play rounds 3 and 4 at Cypress Ridge GC and Lake Shawnee GC respectively. For play at Firekeeper carts will be provided. Firekeeper is located near Mayetta, 1.7 miles West of US-75 Hwy on the north side of 150 Road.

## CITY MATCH PLAY

Qualifying round at Shawnee CC. All players will advance to match play competition at Shawnee CC.

## CITY 2-MAN BEST BALL/CHAPMAN

First round is Best Ball the second round is Modified Chapman format. **Modified Chapman Format:** Both players tee off on each hole. Partners switch and hit the others ball for the second shot. The player whose ball is NOT chosen after the second shot will hit the third shot. Players will then hit **alternately** until the ball is holed.

## CITY SENIORS STROKE PLAY

For this tournament the entry field will be open to Jackson County residents as well. USGA Handicap-Index will be required for the handicap portion of Championship; (no handicap submitted will play at scratch). A handicap is not required for the stroke portion of the Championship. Entry fee includes cart and banquet. Banquet will be held after completion of tournament play.

## PLAYER OF THE YEAR

The TGA will be honoring one player this year that shows his golfing excellence by attaining the highest point total through the current golf season. Points will be awarded in the 4-Man Best Ball, Stroke Play, Match Play Qualifying, Match Play and the 2-Man Best Ball. Points will be awarded to the top 32 players (or teams) in each event. Points awarded will be based on total score for the event; tournament flights will have no impact on the division of points.

## RAIN OUT POLICY

If a tournament is rained out and rescheduled, the rescheduled tournament date will complete the event. **If you are unable to participate it will be assumed that you have withdrawn from the event during the event.** The status of a tournament that is partially rained out will be determined at the discretion of the tournament committee.

## REFUNDS

The TGA's policy is no refunds except for sickness or extenuating circumstances. To withdraw notify the TGA at the P.O. Box or call the participating course.

- **If a player properly withdraws prior to the close of entries, upon proper written notification, the player/team will receive a full refund of the entry fee, less \$25 administrative fee.**
- **If a player properly withdraws three days prior to the start of the event, upon proper written notification, the player/team will receive a refund of 50% of the entry fee.**
- **NO REFUNDS will be made to player that withdraws less than 48 hours prior to the start of the event.**
