ELIGIBILITY

Open to amateur golfers who live or are employed within Shawnee County. Each player must be a member of the Topeka Golf Association (TGA) by paying an annual fee of \$5.00.

DRESS

Players must be properly attired at all times both on the golf course and in public rooms of hosting course. Blue jeans, tee shirts and tank tops are prohibited; shorts must be at least mid-thigh. This dress code will be used at all TGA tournaments and qualifying rounds. **All players will also adhere to any dress codes of the hosting course.** Contestants will comply with the golf spike policy in effect at the host course.

CITY 4-MAN BEST BALL / SHAMBLE

First round is Best Ball second round is shamble format. Two round totals will determine flight winners. Shamble: Each player tees off then the best shot is selected, from that spot each player plays their own ball until holed.

CITY MATCH PLAY

Qualifying round and matches played at Shawnee Country Club. All players will advance to match play competition. If you are under 18 or over 49 years old you may choose the Open Division to be eligible for overall champion and player of the year points. If there are less than eight players in any age group they will be combined with another group or canceled. A minimum of eight players will be required to have a senior division. This can be a combination of the over 50 and the 65 and over if necessary.

CITY CHAMPIONS 2-MAN SCRAMBLE

Open to players age 50 and over. Each round is scramble format. Tee times starting at 9:00 a.m. (front and back). Two round totals will determine flight winners.

CITY STROKE PLAY

Age 50 and over have option to play from the white tees.

CITY JUNIOR CHAMPIONSHIP

Make check payable to: **Topeka Junior Golf** (TGA membership not required for this tournament).

CITY 2-MAN BEST BALL / SCRAMBLE

First round is best ball, second round is scramble. Two round totals will determine flight winners.

CITY CHAMPIONS STROKE PLAY

Open to players age 40 and over. 40-49 will be a separate division (cannot win overall championship). USGA Handicap-Index will be required for the handicap portion of Championship; (no handicap submitted will play at scratch). A handicap is not required for the stroke portion of the Championship. Entry fee includes cart and dinner. Dinner will be held after completion of tournament play.

PLAYER OF THE YEAR

The TGA will be honoring one player this year that shows golfing excellence by attaining the highest point total through the current golf season. Points will be awarded in the 4-Man, Stroke Play, Match Play Qualifying, Match Play and the 2-Man. Points will be awarded to the top 32 players (or teams) in each event. Points awarded will be based on total score for the event; tournament flights will have no impact on the division of points.

RAIN OUT POLICY

If a tournament is rained out and rescheduled, the rescheduled tournament date will complete the event. If you are unable to participate it will be assumed that you have withdrawn from the event during the event. The status of a tournament that is partially rained out will be determined at the discretion of the tournament committee.

REFUNDS

The TGA's policy is no refunds except for sickness or extenuating circumstances. To withdraw notify the TGA at the P.O. Box or call the participating course.

- If a player properly withdraws prior to the close of entries, upon proper written notification, the player/team will receive a full refund of the entry fee, less \$25 administrative fee.
- If a player properly withdraws three days prior to the start of the event, upon proper written notification, the player/team will receive a refund of 50% of the entry fee.
- NO REFUNDS will be made to player that withdraws less than 48 hours prior to the start of the event.
